

Born in Thessaloniki, Greece, **Theodoros Papadimitriou** is a graduate of the Department of Music Studies at Aristotle University and holds a Master of Music in performance (conducting) from the University of Hull. He holds a diploma in violoncello and piano, and has studied harmony, counterpoint and fugue. Theodoros is currently in his final year of studies in orchestra conducting at Thessaloniki State Conservatory under Vladimiros Simeonides. He has attended master classes in conducting with Michael Dittrich, Dominique Rouits, and Manuel Hernández-Silva. Since 2011 he is the conductor of the youth sinfonietta and the children's orchestra of the New Conservatory of Thessaloniki, regularly composing educational works for both. He composes music for films and theatrical plays, and performs frequently as a cellist, collaborating with artists and ensembles of various music genres.
